



RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF PARENTS

Rights

1. To inquire about the condition and progress of their children in school.
2. To organize by themselves and /or with teachers for the purpose of providing a forum for the discussion of matters relating to the total school program and for ensuring the full cooperation of parents and teachers in the formulation and efficient implementation of such programs (Education Act of 1982, Ch. 2, Sec. 8).
3. To have access to any official record directly relating to their children who are under their parental responsibility

Duties

1. To read and sign Assignment Notebooks every day.
 2. To follow up remarks and communications from the school.
 3. To settle punctually financial obligations to the school.
 4. To participate in the meetings and activities organized by the school for the parents.
 5. To follow up the progress of their child in school.
 6. To seek the cooperation and assistance of the school in whatever will promote the welfare of their son.
 7. To personally get the report card of their child whenever deemed necessary.
 8. To be role models of their children in virtues and values.
 9. To exercise respect towards the administration, faculty, school personnel and fellow parents.
 10. To know and support the policies and guidelines of the school indicated in the Student.
